AS/NZS 4801, OHSAS 18001, SafetyMAP & injuryMAP

## The OH&S Standards

AS/NZS 4801:2001 is used as the benchmark to assess Occupational Health & Safety Management systems for organizations. Whilst this is an Australian/ New Zealand Standard, organizations in other countries have adopted the requirements.

In July 2007 a new version of internationally recognized OHSAS 18001 was released, this time as a standard. SAI Global has clients with operations in multiple countries, and like them you may choose a single management systems certification to cover all operations, and OHSAS could be a prudent choice.

## SafetyMAP & injuryMAP

SafetyMAP and injuryMAP have assisted organizations in demonstrating their OH&S commitments throughout Australia. Though initially established in Victoria, the requirements of both programs have been taken up by organizations in other states, particularly those that have operations in Victoria and elsewhere and wish to have a harmonized OH&S management system.

The checklist style approach of SafetyMAP assists clients to plan their implementation, and organizations can choose to be assessed against either the initial or advanced level. The key differences are:

- **Initial Level** – foundations of an OH&S system to meet minimum legislative criteria.
- **Advanced** – incorporates the benchmarking your system with best practice and maintenance and improvement of the system.

injuryMAP provides a framework for improving and measuring your system for managing employees injured in the workplace.

## Management System Benefits

The benefits of an OH&S Management System go well beyond external recognition, and can include:

- Establishment of goals and policies
- Planning and identification of hazards and the assessment and control of risks.
- Emergency preparedness and response
- Monitoring, measurement and records management
- Internal audits of procedures and management reviews of the system.
