The ISO 31000 Approach

ISO 31000 is intended to be used by a wide range of stakeholders including;

- those responsible for implementing risk management within their organisation;
- those who need to ensure that an organisation manages risk;
- those who need to manage risk for the organisation as a whole or within a specific area or activity;
- those needing to evaluate an organisation's practices in managing risk; and
- developers of standards, guides, procedures, and codes of practice that in whole or in part set out how risk is to be managed within the specific context of these documents.

SAI Global assessors will review the systems that have been established and implemented to determine;

- the extent and type of risks that are tolerable, and how unacceptable risks are to be treated,
- how risk assessment integrates into organisational processes,
- methods and techniques to be used for risk assessment, and their contribution to the risk management process,

- resources available to carry out risk assessment,
- how the risk assessment will be reported and reviewed.
