



# Integrated Management Systems for Managers

This half-day (4 hour) Integrated Management Systems Awareness course (ISO 45001:2018, ISO 14001:2015 and ISO 9001:2015) is intended for those with a basic knowledge of quality, environmental and occupational health and safety management systems.

This course is suited to Managers and supervisors of teams that currently have management systems incorporated into their business function and are looking to understand further the options for integrating their management systems across multiple disciplines. (ISO 9001, ISO 14001, ISO 45011)

- Discuss the changes to recently released ISO standards (ISO 9001, ISO 14001, ISO 45001) what the differences are and how these changes are to be managed
- Describe the high level structure of Annex SL, its relationship with ISO management system standards and the potential it offers for integrated management systems
- Describe how audit findings and non-conformances are actioned and implemented
